

# GORDON HEAD LAWN BOWLING CLUB

## CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

(incorporated under the Society Act  
of British Columbia, 28 October 1992,  
Certificate S29703)

### PART 1 - CONSTITUTION

1. **NAME:** The name of the Society shall be "Gordon Head Lawn Bowling Club", hereinafter referred to as "the Club".
2. **PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Club is to promote, foster and safeguard the game of lawn bowls, and to encourage and maintain friendly participation among the members of the Club.
3. **AFFILIATIONS:** The club shall be affiliated with the British Columbia Lawn Bowling Association and the South Vancouver Island Lawn Bowling Association, provided that such affiliations may be discontinued by a majority of votes at any Annual or Semi-Annual Meeting of the Club, or by any special meeting of the Club called for that purpose. The per capita fees levied by these associations shall be paid when due. The "Laws of the Game", as laid down by the International Bowling Board, shall govern all Club games and matches, subject always to special rules made and posted by the Games Committee of the Club, where necessary. This provision is unalterable.
4. **WINDING UP:** In the event of the winding up or dissolution of the Club, the funds and assets of the Club remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities shall be given or such organisation(s) concerned with

community social problems, or organisations promoting the same purpose as the Club, as may be determined by the members of the Club at the time of winding-up or dissolution, and if effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then such funds shall be given or transferred to some other organisations(s), provided however that such organisation(s) referred to in this paragraph shall be a registered charity or charities recognised by Revenue Canada Taxation as being qualified as such under the provisions of the Income Tax Act of Canada from time to time in effect. This paragraph is unalterable in terms of the Society Act.
