Tile Rummy

The game is best for four participants, playing two against two partners. Therefore, the rules for the four-hand version Euchre is a trick-taking card game commonly played in Canada, New Zealand, Great Britain, and the United States. Normally there are four players, two on each team, are variations that range from two to nine players.

Euchre uses a non standard deck of 24 cards. It's the 9, 10, Jack, Queen, King and Ace of each suit. Some use the Joker, but this version does not. The initial dealer randomly, in the next round the player to the dealer's left dealer and so on. Five cards are dealt to each player in dealing. Once all players have their cards, the top card of
